I was thinking about prayer recently. Why and when do we pray? Who do we pray to and what do we hope to gain from it? Are there particular circumstances that promote and encourage prayer?

Then a rather uncomfortable thought came to me. When I pray, I tend to **ask** God for help with - my family, people in need, nations etc. So much asking!!

I try and give thanks too, but somehow there is litany of wants. I started to feel sorry for God – what a crew of moaners we are- forever dissatisfied and yet asking for more.

We must have a tolerant and patient God to hear us out and look kindly on us.

But there is one very simple prayer which my granddaughter taught me when she was at Primary school. She graduated from university last month and I have continued to say this prayer most days since she first taught it to me.

I like the fact that although there is some asking within it, it is a simple code of behaviour which guides my thinking, speaking and doing. That guidance is the essence of prayer. I hope you may want to learn and use it too....

Dear Father God
Be with me today
And help me in all
I think, do and say. Amen
