Christmas is upon us again. For many this represents the opportunity to spend a lot of money but also perhaps to meet up with distant family members that we haven't seen or heard of for a long time. Those of us who also focus on the reason for Christmas can only wonder at the reaction of Mary when she learned that she was to be the Mother of Jesus.

Much has been written about Mary both before, during and after the event. In fact an American film - Mary, Mother of Jesus - was made in 1999. Perhaps 'Why Me?' was an early reaction. No doubt many people have attempted to discern what the teenage Mary's reaction might have been but the news would have been very dramatic.

Mary went on to become a leading and widely travelled figure in the history of Christianity. You may have seen her tomb in the Garden of Gethsemane in Jerusalem or her home in Ephesus. She is also, of course, the Patron Saint of our Church among many others.

As we celebrate the birth of Jesus, perhaps we can also remember and celebrate the life of his Mother.
