Thought for the Day by Debbie Barwell

Whilst seeking inspiration for this week's thought for the day, I stumbled upon the fact that 14th December is the feast day of St John of the Cross. Having never heard of this 16th Century Spanish saint, I decided to find out more.

John, or Juan, was born into poverty and raised in an orphanage. He became a Catholic priest and a Carmelite friar and was imprisoned for months as the result of a misunderstanding. John was incarcerated in a tiny cell in Toledo for nine months with the only light coming through a small slit

high up in the wall. While John could have fallen into despair, instead he chose to spend the time in prayer, listening to God and deepening his understanding of God's love. On his release, John willingly forgave those who had imprisoned him. When asked how he was able to forgive those who had persecuted him so cruelly and unjustly, he simply said, 'where there is no love, put love and you will draw out love.'

These words seem to have a special resonance at this time of year. Our world feels threatened by darkness but, perhaps, in sharing God's love in small ways we too can bring a little light to the darkness this Christmas.


